Data Collection Proposal Scope

The proposed site from the ITE Student Chapter at the University of Hawai'i (ITE at UH Mānoa) for the 2023 ITE Western Data Collection Fund is Hale Pawa'a. Hale Pawa'a is a Medical Care Center located in Honolulu, Hawai'i. Hale Pawa'a is a nine-story, 127,268 square feet (sf) medical office building featuring specialty clinics, office spaces, diagnostic imaging, diagnostic laboratory and pharmacy space. The adjacent eight-story, 161,900 sf parking structure houses 400 parking stalls (see Figure 1).

Data collection of trips, vehicle occupancy, and parked vehicles will be conducted through manual counts. In addition, bicycles and pedestrians will be counted when entering and exiting the facility. Data will be collected at the site over a span of a month. Two weekday counts and one weekend count will be performed. Data collection will occur from 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM for a 12 consecutive hour span. Data Collection will be collected by members of ITE at UH Mānoa and students from CEE 462 Traffic Engineering, with class credit to be awarded to CEE 462 students participating in the data collection project at the proposed site. Data for trip generation and parking will be collected according to ITE's Trip Generation Manual, 10th Edition.

Mentoring

Jennylyn Tapat and Cathy Leong, traffic engineers at Wilson Okamoto Corporation, will serve as the mentors for ITE at UH Mānoa's Data Collection project providing oversight and assistance in the data collection project. Dr. Roger Chen is the faculty advisor for ITE at UH Mānoa and will also provide additional assistance throughout the data collection project.

Level of Effort

The total level of effort for this study is expected to be 80 person hours. The ITE Student Chapter Data Collection Committee will consist of students from CEE 462 Traffic Engineering Class and ITE Student Chapter Members. Each student would spend on average 2 hours on the data collection effort for approximately 60 person hours. In addition, members of the student chapter Data Collection Committee will commit 20 person hours on the Data Processing and Report Preparation. Summarized in Table 1 is the level of effort broken down.
